Pinstripe Kit Installation Instructions

- 1. Clean thoroughly general area of vehicle where pinstripe is to be applied. 91% Isopropyl Alcohol is commonly recommended by manufacturer for the removing of both dirt, waxes, and airborne/road grease. (available at Walmart, Target, etc.) Use clean virgin towels or cloths to insure area is not contaminated.
- 2. Use small pieces of tape to set accurate gaps from selected feature line, to help insure accuracy of pinstripe placement.
- 3. Lay pinstripe by first removing a panel length of paper backing. Press after applying. Continue for vehicle. Not recommended to apply on hot surfaced vehicles. Stripe in the shaded area.
- 4. After side is complete, remove clear carrier, carefully by pulling it over stripe area, not upwards or downwards, so that carrier does not cause vinyl pinstripes to move or squiggle.
- 5. After clear carrier is removed, press down vinyl pinstripes with fingers to insure proper contact and bonding and adhesion.
- 6. Trim vinyl back from doors about 1/8". We recommend using a curved blade; these keep knife blade from cutting or scoring paint.
- 7. Trim-in logos and name-decals at desired areas. Install fancy front arrows or fashion a traditional point bringing bottom stripe up to top stripe.
- 8. Vehicle can be washed anytime afterwards HOWEVER, if a power wash is used, we strongly recommend wand sprayer head is kept minimum 24" away from vehicle. Power washers used up-close can damage stripes.
